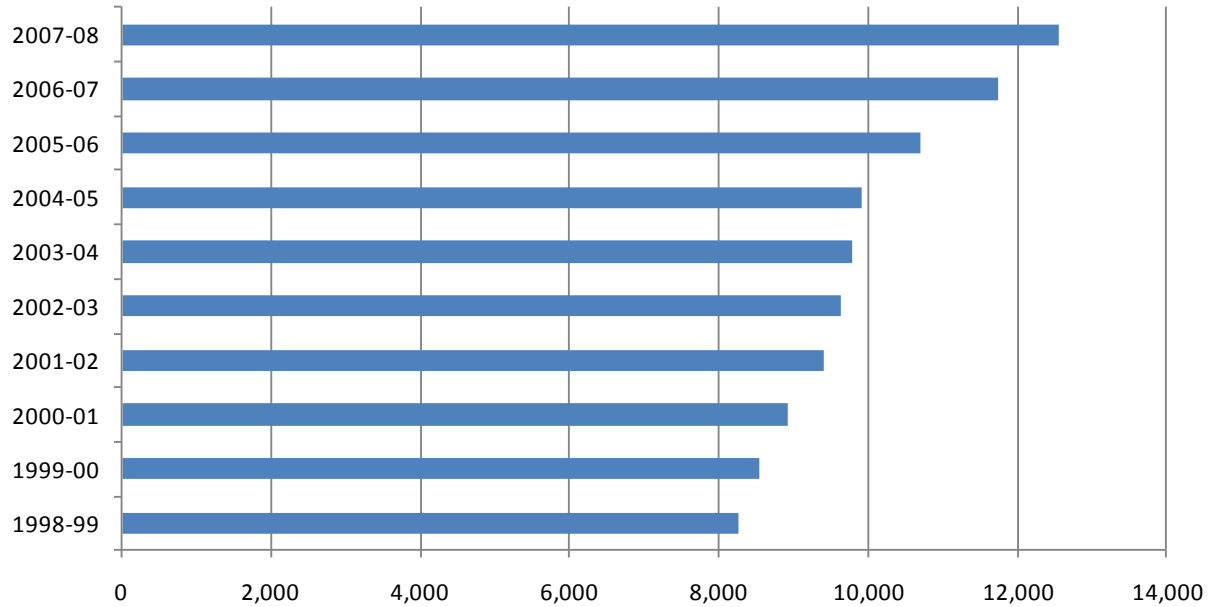

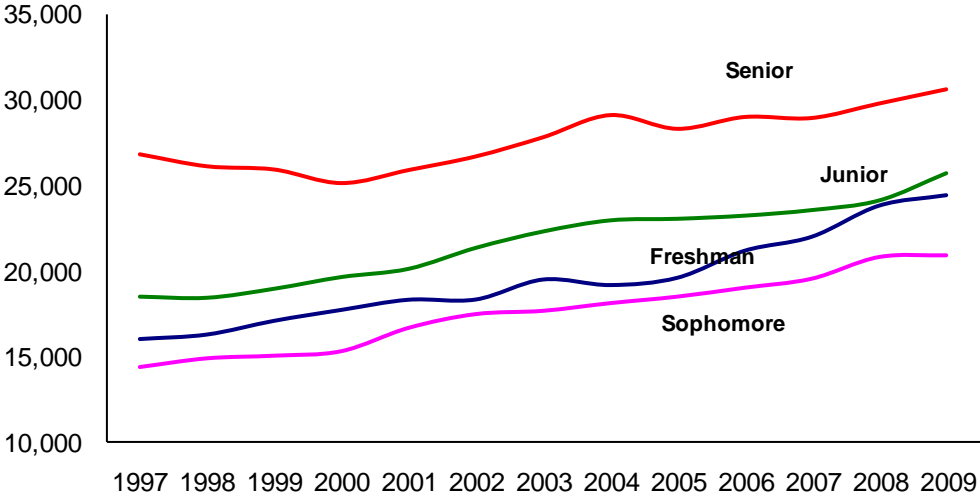

 Percentage of Students Who Are Non-Resident**

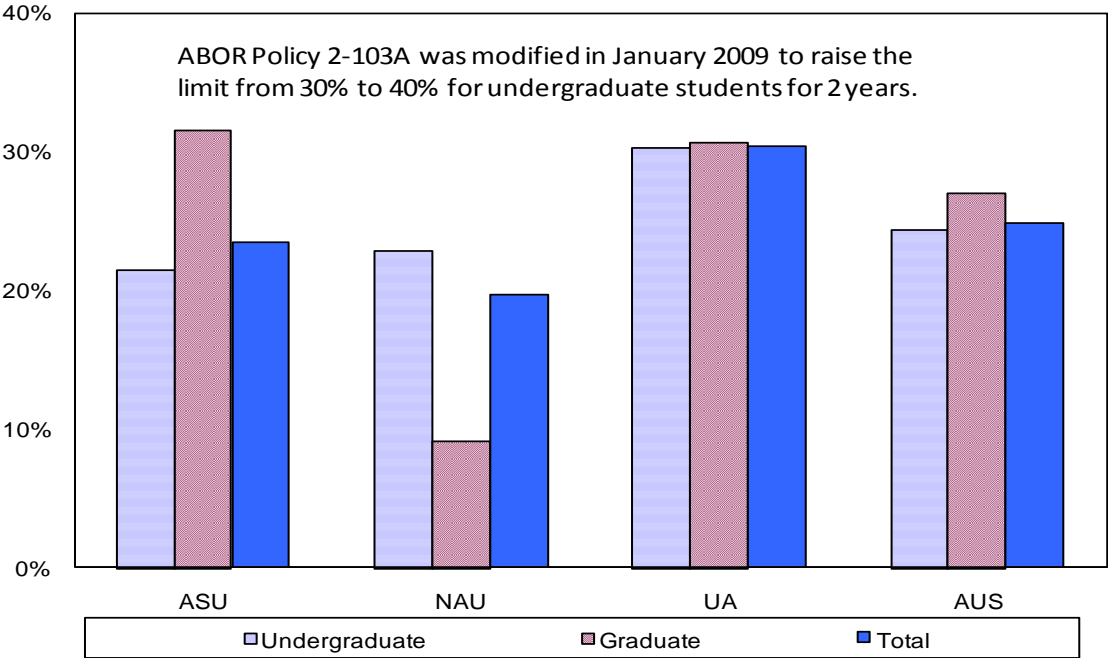

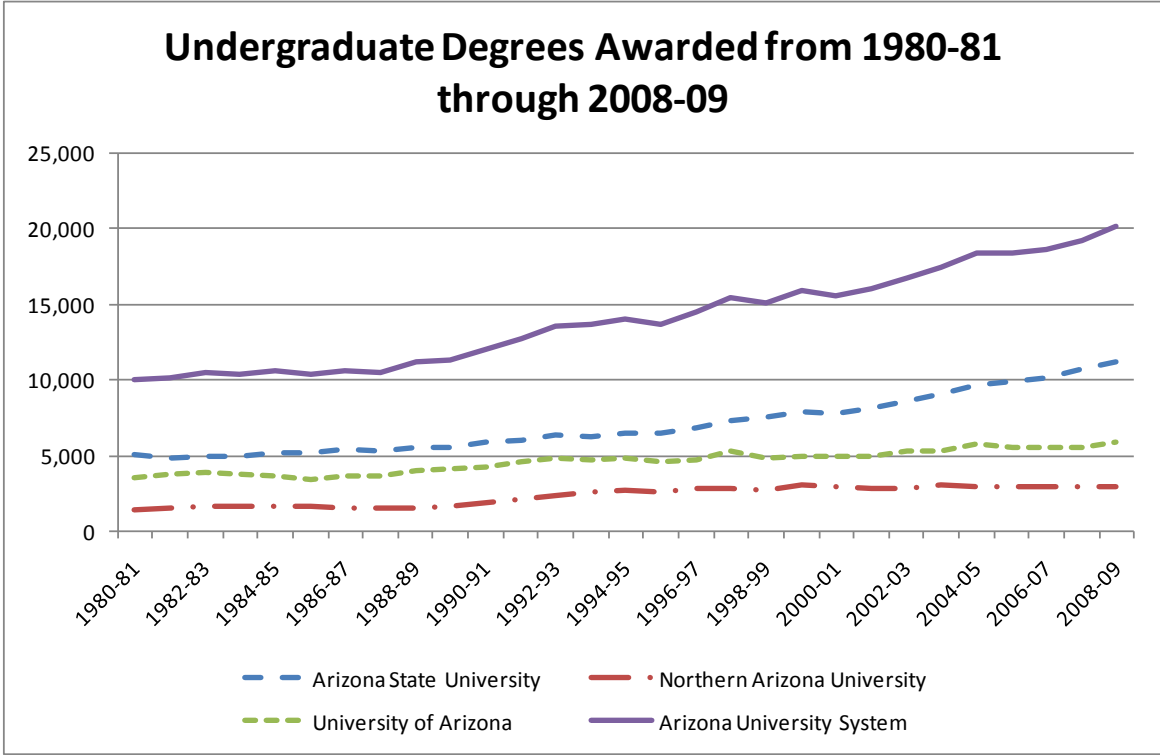
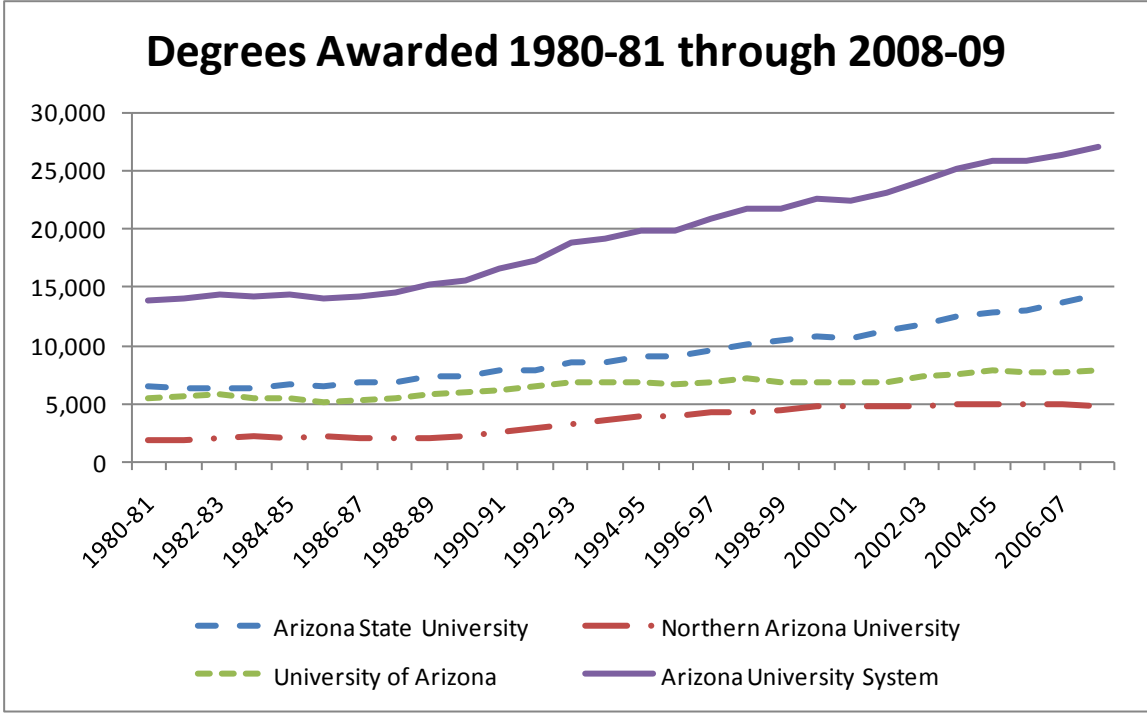
